




SHEET MOSS
INSTALLATION GUIDE





Ensure the area where you plan to install the panel is the correct size for your moss panel. Use a measuring tape to determine where to place it.





- 2. If the wall has dust or dirt, wipe it down with a clean cloth.
- 3 If your moss panel is too large for your space, use scissors or knife to trim the edges to fit your desired dimensions. Be gentle when trimming to avoid damaging the moss.

Hold the moss panel against the wall in your desired position.



- 5. Use a measuring tape to find the correct position. Ensure it's level using a level tool.
- 6. Fasten the panel to the wall using drywall screws.





Once you have finished installing all the panels onto the wall, you will notice there are seams showing between each panel.



To hide the seams, you will need to pull back both layers of sheet moss along the edge, apply hot glue to the undersides, and push them back against the panels. You can rip away a small section of sheet moss from either side of the seam and replace it with a piece that fits in order to achieve the same result.





- If the moss is sticking out from the edges of the panel or not aligning properly, you can carefully trim the excess with scissors.
- Use the air blower to remove dust or debris that may have settled on the panels during the installation process.









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
